DIRECTOR'S NOTES



I'm thinking that once a group produces the same musical twice, that finally certifies it as a legitimate theater organization, right?! Welcome to *Annie* – our Summer, 2012 production, and Music West's first-ever repeat show! It's hard to believe that we are already eight years young, and performing our 12th full scale production for Westchester audiences. Much has changed since the last *Annie* (and a special mention of the four ladies who have been members of both casts – Carmen, Natalie, Amy and Brittany!), but our core mission remains the same – providing positive musical experiences for our cast members through the production of quality entertainment for our audiences. We hope that during the past eight years, we have accomplished that mission in some way for you!

Annie is a classic musical, well-known and loved by millions (especially the movie musical version from 1982), and if I had my choice I'd probably want to produce it every year (but I think ticket sales just "might" taper off a bit after the third or fourth run...??) In place of the usual program notes, I'd like to highlight the optimistic theme of this show, embodied by many of the fantastic musical numbers (such as "NYC" and "You Won't Be an Orphan for Long"), but particularly "Tomorrow". As many of you may know, our friend and cast member, Brittany Gunnell, was critically injured last month in a bicycle accident. Brittany, who was playing the adult female lead role of Grace Farrell, is also known for her performances in Music West's productions of *The Sound of Music* (where, at 12 years old, she played both Baroness Elsa and Reverend Mother Abbess!); *The Music Man* (as Marion the Librarian), and in our last *Annie*, where she performed as the talented "Star to Be" among other roles in the show. The Cast, Production Team, and I dedicate this year's production of *Annie* to Brittany, and we continue to pray for her full recovery. She has been making major strides lately, and we remain optimistic about "tomorrow" – knowing that she will return to the stage once again!

I could not overstate how much fun it has been to work with this cast and volunteer team! The Board and I knew that with the selection of *Annie*, we would certainly be seeing many new people joining us to play the younger orphans. What we did not expect was that over 70 percent of our cast would consist of talented new faces – and after only 4 months, it definitely seems like they have always been here! I continue to be especially happy with the growth in family participation – we not only have multiple members from seven different families, but are also thrilled that we have FOUR "parent-child" combinations (and even an Uncle for good measure!). Many of the parents and families were also involved consistently during rehearsals, volunteering to help with dances, costuming, supervision, or just supporting the process and preparations for Opening Night. Our hope is that this trend will continue to grow – I always have such fond memories of performing in a musical with my Dad many years ago (and now alongside Laura and our daughter Marlee) and it has been great to see others have a similar experience...and how about building a parade float in just 3 hours?!

The level of enthusiasm has been "high" since day one – I remember at auditions, when we had the group sing for the first time together, we were amazed at the energetic sound that was present, even before one rehearsal had occurred! The cast members seemed to feel this as well, and have done a truly remarkable job working with each other over the past few months, bringing their awesome, individual talents together into a cast which we are all proud to share with you in just a few moments. Each of these cast members has become a very special and valued member of this group, and I am particularly grateful to Ilona Kulinska, who stepped in to play the "Grace" role in Brittany's absence. Ilona joined us just a few weeks ago and mastered her role, and achieved a wonderful comfort level with the cast, within a couple of days!

I am, as always, deeply indebted to the many Production Team members and volunteers who have contributed to making this show possible as well. Our Board of Directors was truly an active group during this production – each one taking on a different area and "running with it" so we could "share the load" – Karen (who again attended nearly every rehearsal), Anna, Eddie, Debbie and Carolyn - each making valuable donations of their time, effort and resources throughout the year, but especially during the past four months. It seems that the family aspect of the group was expanded with us personally as well – as Laura added choreography to her tremendous musical leadership, and Marlee was only too happy to "test" the dances and even the lighting programs for us (and anyone else whom she could find – and of course had to have different dress-up outfits, which my Mom (Liz) consistently provided)! We are grateful as well to Arielle and Hannah for sharing their talents with us and assisting with the choreography, and the many team volunteers listed in our program – especially Mary Michlovich for "spreading the word" right at the beginning and encouraging so many new folks to join us, Jennifer Kaczor and Sheila Higbie for attending almost every rehearsal and "corralling" the younger ones, Joanna Panosian for donating many costume supplies and time, Shannon and Anna Cody for sharing their graphic art creations, Paige DeMarco for coming in to assist with the set crew, and Teressa Syta for her musical advice and encouragement!

As you know, we exist as a source of family entertainment in Westchester primarily through our sponsors and benefactors. We are extremely grateful to all of our supporters, and in particular MCL and Associates, the Westchester Woman's Club, and Mr. Eddie Ozawa, for their overwhelming generosity! 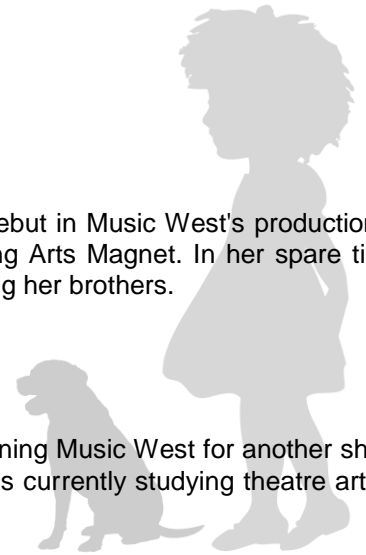
Kailey Torres (Duffy) – Kailey Torres was born an artist at heart. She has participated in her school's talent show two years in a row and is part of her church choir.
