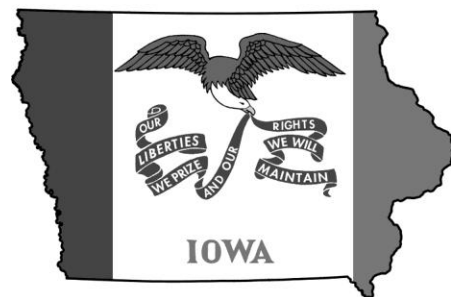

On behalf of Music West, Inc. Board of Directors, Production team and cast, welcome to our Summer 2015 production, The Music Man. The Music Man is a classic production that families everywhere can enjoy.

Last summer toward the end of our production of The Sound of Music, Jeff Remington mentioned possibly passing the director's title to someone else. I jumped at the opportunity. Having performed in 20 productions previously, four with Music West, I felt that I was ready to take on a leadership role.
