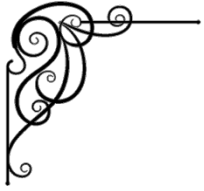

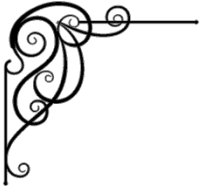
Hello all, and thank you for attending our production of *Hello, Dolly!*

Since 1964, *Hello, Dolly!* has been transporting audiences to turn of the century America through song, dance, comedy, and limitless amounts of charm and wit.
