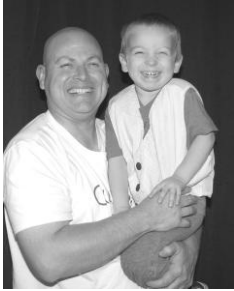

# DIRECTOR'S NOTE



Howdy Y'all!

Last year, during South Pacific, we began what may have become a new tradition or "standard procedure" for our group – creating a "static set" that is in place for the entire show, requiring very minimal (and short!) scene changes. For obvious reasons, our backstage crew (myself included) greatly enjoyed this approach, and was highly in favor of attempting it again for this year's production of Oklahoma! Creatin' a set and throwin' down our hammers are a couple of my daughter's and my favorite things to do, so we set out tryin' it again.

Drawin' inspiration from some of our favorite scenes of this type (including a country farmhouse we once had in good ole' Lowell, Indiana; "The Land" pavilion at Florida's newfangled Epcot Center; and yes, even that peaceful entry from that western favorite, "Pirates of the Caribbean"), we assembled quite a collection of Middle America-type props and scenery. That there beautiful backdrop, painted by famed western artist Gina Bellous for our last production of this show in 2011, was brought back with a bit a TLC by that chuck wagon proprietor Eddie Ozawa, and many cast members and families circled their wagons around the effort. With a static set, the different settings and time periods that y'all will see in the show will mostly be done through the use of high-techie lighting effects, (made possible by some kinda upgraded LED color thingys courtesy of all you generous sponsors and donors sharin' your treasure!).

As enjoyable as the set design process is, it wouldn't mean much without a cast and a bunch of ranch hands (your "production team")! We reached a new milestone with the talented cast y'all will soon enjoy – at 36, the largest ever, we've gone 'bout as far as we kin go! Along with a dedicated production team, led by Stage Manager/Range Boss, and renowned scribbler (author) Mark Calde, Choreographer and square dancer extraordinaire Kaitlyn Schwerdtfeger, Technical Director/ropin' expert Leslie Dennis, and all the Team Leads and Volunteers, Laura and I enjoyed the infectious enthusiasm and talent which we had the privilege of experiencing over the past few months. That wide age range of farmers and cattle drivers continues expandin', and new families who joined the stampede this year brought lotsa ideas and energy to the round up! Once again, we were fortunate to have the Drollinger Family/Music West Production Leadership Training Program, with Luke using his force to keep the lamps burnin', and Andres capably takin' on directing some scenes and musical revues, in addition to peddlin' his stuff to anyone who'd listen. Hannah, the VP of somethin' or other, ponied up again as a vital leader, not only on stage singin' her heart out, but as a "sounding board" (who done has no fear of soundin' back!) and trusted advisor throughout these parts. Eddie joined us again at the O-K corral as the "last man standing", a stayin' into the 0-Dark-Hundred hours to polish off that set and house area, as well as Anna Cody's tireless work on postin' those playbills and this here program. Michael and Kathy Kramer, Dave Brown and Adrienne "quick draw" Geffen continue providin' unmatched musicianship with those banjos and washboards, and with those talented folks on stage, the combo has become a recognizable "Music West" sound!



Music West's Board of Directors, joined this year by Mary "Aunt Eller" Michlovich, has kept us a movin' westward ho along the ole' Corduroy Road, givin' steadfast leadership and expertise, and allowin' us to keep offering live, family entertainment for y'all. With your support and showin' up each year, we're hopin' to see many more a these things play out for you in the future! Thank ya'll for comin' today, and let's git on with the show!

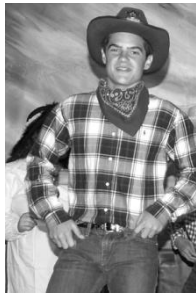

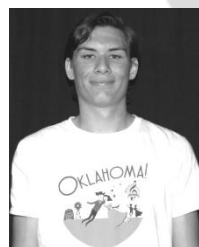

Andrea has also had a passion for golf and guitar.



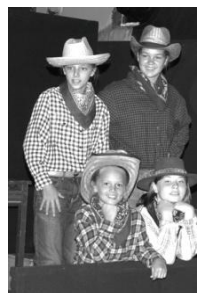
