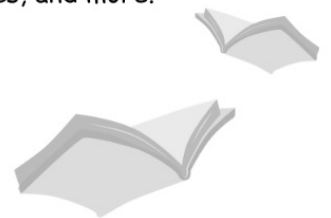
Laura Hummasti - Mrs. Wormwood/Ensemble

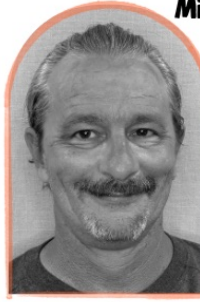
Meet the Cast

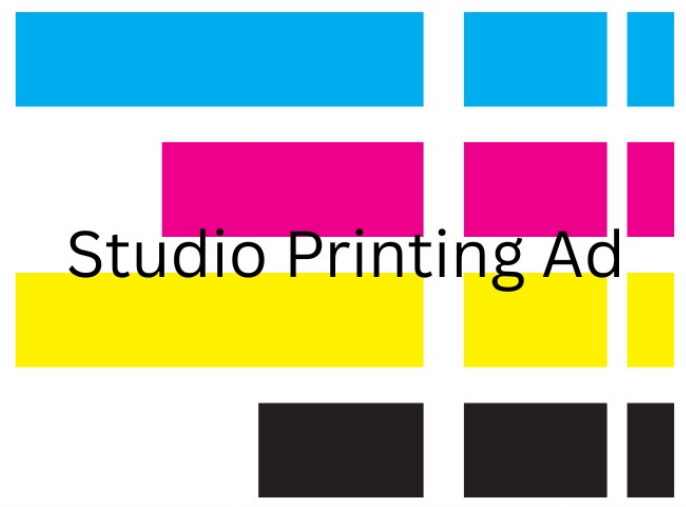

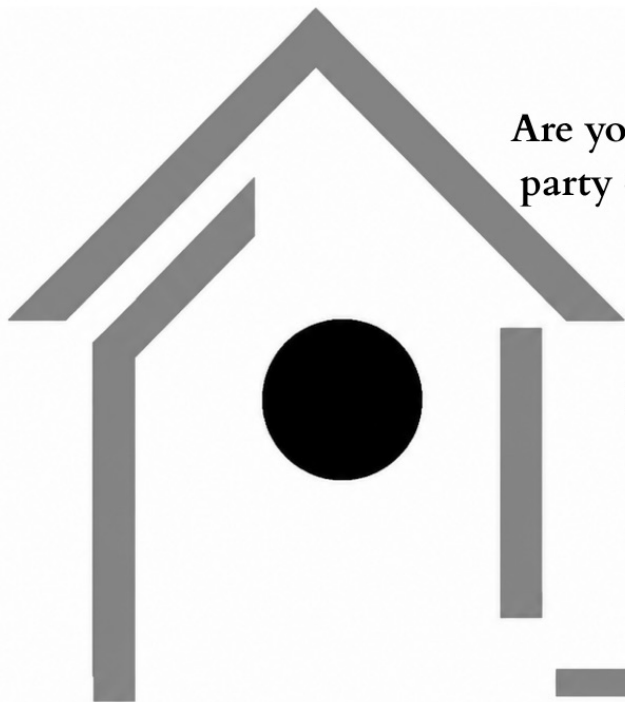

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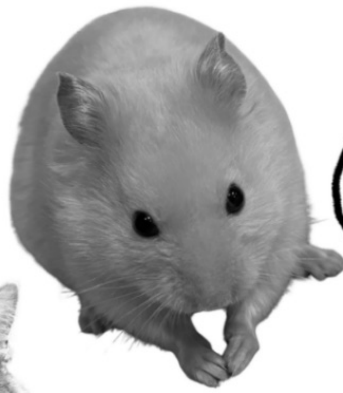
